A BILL

To supersede certain judicial orders interfering with the implementation of amendments to section 235 of the Immigration and Nationality Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUPERSEDING JUDICIAL ORDERS PRECEDING**
4 **REVISION OF PROCEDURES FOR REMOVAL**
5 **OF ALIENS.**

6 The provisions of section 235 of the Immigration and
7 Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1225) (as in effect on the date
8 of the enactment of this Act) supersede any court order
9 issued prior to the effective date specified in section
10 309(a) of the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant

1 Responsibility Act of 1996 (8 U.S.C. 1101 note), if the
2 court order affects the ability of the Secretary of Home-
3 land Security to carry out expedited removal of inadmis-
4 sible arriving aliens in accordance with such section 235.
