## AN ACT

To amend the National Trails System Act to designate the  
Captain John Smith Chesapeake National Historic Trail.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Captain John Smith  
3 Chesapeake National Historic Trail Designation Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. ADDITION TO NATIONAL SCENIC AND NATIONAL**  
5 **HISTORIC TRAILS.**

6 Section 5(a) of the National Trails System Act (16  
7 U.S.C. 1244(a)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
8 lowing:

9 “(25) CAPTAIN JOHN SMITH CHESAPEAKE NA-  
10 TIONAL HISTORIC TRAIL.—

11 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The John Smith  
12 Chesapeake National Historic Trail, a series of  
13 water routes extending approximately 3,000  
14 miles along the Chesapeake Bay and the tribu-  
15 taries of the Chesapeake Bay in the States of  
16 Virginia, Maryland, and Delaware, and in the  
17 District of Columbia, that traces the 1607-1609  
18 voyages of Captain John Smith to chart the  
19 land and waterways of the Chesapeake Bay, as  
20 generally depicted on the map entitled ‘Captain  
21 John Smith Chesapeake National Historic Trail  
22 Map MD, VA, DE, and DC’, numbered P-16/  
23 8000 (CAJO), and dated May 2006.

24 “(B) MAP.—The map referred to in sub-  
25 paragraph (A) shall be on file and available for

1 public inspection in the appropriate offices of  
2 the National Park Service.

3 “(C) ADMINISTRATION.—The trail shall be  
4 administered by the Secretary of the Interior—

5 “(i) in coordination with—

6 “(I) the Chesapeake Bay Gate-  
7 ways and Watertrails Network author-  
8 ized under the Chesapeake Bay Initia-  
9 tive Act of 1998 (16 U.S.C. 461 note;  
10 112 Stat. 2961); and

11 “(II) the Chesapeake Bay Pro-  
12 gram authorized under section 117 of  
13 the Federal Water Pollution Control  
14 Act (33 U.S.C. 1267); and

15 “(ii) in consultation with—

16 “(I) other Federal, State, tribal,  
17 regional, and local agencies; and

18 “(II) the private sector.

19 “(D) LAND ACQUISITION.—The United  
20 States shall not acquire for the trail any land  
21 or interest in land outside the exterior boundary  
22 of any federally-managed area without the con-  
23 sent of the owner of the land or interest in  
24 land.”.

1 **SEC. 3. CHANGE IN AUTHORIZATION.**

2 Section 4 of the Act of July 3, 1930 (16 U.S.C. 81f),  
3 is amended in the first sentence by striking “10,472,000”  
4 and inserting “8,572,000”.
