## A BILL

To make amendments to the Reclamation Projects  
Authorization and Adjustment Act of 1992.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RECLAMATION PROJECTS AUTHORIZATION**

4 **AND ADJUSTMENT ACT AMENDMENTS.**

5 Section 1631 of the Reclamation Projects Authoriza-  
6 tion and Adjustment Act of 1992, as amended by Public  
7 Law 104–266 (43 U.S.C. 390h–13), is amended—

8 (1) in subsection (a), by inserting before the pe-  
9 riod the following: “, including Phase II of the  
10 Olivenhain Water Treatment Plant”; and

1           (2) in subsection (b)(2), by adding at the end  
2           the following: “Notwithstanding any other provision  
3           of this title, the Federal share of the costs of the  
4           projects for which funds are made available under  
5           this section shall not exceed \$35,000,000.”.
