Mrs. JO ANN DAVIS of Virginia introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to clarify the authority of the Secretary of a military department, or the Secretary of Homeland Security in the case of the Coast Guard, to sell untreated water located on military installations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SALE OF CERTAIN UTILITIES AND SERVICES.**

4 Section 2686 of title 10, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
6 section:

1 “(d) If a proposed sale under this section consists
2 solely of untreated water, the Secretary concerned, in
3 making the determination required by subsection (a) re-
4 garding whether the utility or related service to be sold
5 is available from other local sources, shall not consider—
6 “(1) the availability of treated water from any
7 local source; or
8 “(2) the availability of untreated water from
9 another local source that is situated outside of the
10 political subdivision in which the military facility
11 that will supply the untreated water is located.”.
