## A BILL

To suspend the antidumping duty orders on imports of solid  
urea from Russia and Ukraine.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF ANTIDUMPING DUTIES ON**

4                       **SOLID UREA FROM RUSSIA AND UKRAINE.**

5       (a) SUSPENSION.—No antidumping duty deposit  
6 shall be required upon entry of the products described in  
7 subsection (b), and no antidumping duty shall be assessed  
8 on such products, notwithstanding the antidumping duty  
9 orders of the Department of Commerce in the cases A–  
10 821–801 (Russia) and A–823–801 (Ukraine).

1       (b) PRODUCTS.—The products referred to in sub-  
2 section (a) are solid urea products classified under sub-  
3 heading 3102.10.00 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of  
4 the United States that are imported from Russia or  
5 Ukraine.

6       (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section applies to prod-  
7 ucts described in subsection (b) entered, or withdrawn  
8 from warehouse for consumption, for the period beginning  
9 on the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this  
10 Act.
