## A BILL

To prohibit the proposed sale to Pakistan of F-16 aircraft and related defense articles and defense services unless Pakistan has halted construction of a certain plutonium production reactor.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON SALE TO PAKISTAN OF F-16**  
4                               **AIRCRAFT AND RELATED DEFENSE ARTICLES**  
5                               **AND SERVICES UNLESS CONSTRUCTION OF**  
6                               **NUCLEAR REACTOR TERMINATED.**

7       (a) PROHIBITION.—The President may not sell to  
8       Pakistan the items described in subsection (b) unless the

1 President has certified to the Congress that Pakistan has  
2 terminated construction of the plutonium production reac-  
3 tor in Khushab, Pakistan.

4 (b) DESCRIPTION OF ITEMS.—The items referred to  
5 in subsection (a) are the following items, as set forth in  
6 the notifications to Congress on June 28, 2006, of the pro-  
7 posed sale of the items to Pakistan:

8 (1) F-16C/D Block 50/52 aircraft, and associ-  
9 ated equipment and services.

10 (2) F-16A/B Mid-Life Update Modification  
11 kits, and associated equipment and services.

12 (3) F-16 engine modifications and Falcon UP/  
13 STAR structural upgrades, and associated equip-  
14 ment and services.

15 (4) Weapons for F-16C/D Block 50/52 aircraft,  
16 and associated equipment and services.
