A BILL

To amend the Legal Services Corporation Act to provide appropriate removal procedures for the Inspector General, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Legal Services Cor-
5 poration Improvement Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. APPOINTMENT AND REMOVAL OF THE INSPECTOR**

7 **GENERAL.**

8 Section 1005 of the Legal Services Corporation Act
9 (42 U.S.C. 2996d) is amended—

1 (1) in the heading of the section, by striking
2 “AND EMPLOYEES” and inserting “, EMPLOYEES,
3 AND THE INSPECTOR GENERAL”;

4 (2) at the end of the section, by adding the fol-
5 lowing new subsection:

6 “(h)(1) The Board shall appoint and shall have the
7 power to remove the Inspector General, in accordance with
8 section 8G of the Inspector General Act of 1978.

9 “(2) The Inspector General may at any time be re-
10 moved upon the written concurrence of at least 9 members
11 of the Board. Nothing in this subsection shall be consid-
12 ered to exempt the Board from the requirements of section
13 8G(e) of the Inspector General Act of 1978.”.
