Mr. DICKS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs

A BILL

To require the establishment of a Department of Veterans Affairs outpatient clinic at the Olympic Medical Center, Port Angeles, Washington.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF A DE-**
4 **PARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS OUT-**
5 **PATIENT CLINIC, PORT ANGELES, WASH-**
6 **INGTON.**

7 (a) ESTABLISHMENT OF CLINIC.—The Secretary of
8 Veterans Affairs shall enter into an agreement with
9 Clallam County, Washington, to provide for the location
10 at the Olympic Medical Center, Port Angeles, Washington,

1 of a Department of Veterans Affairs veterans' outpatient
2 clinic for the provision of outpatient services to eligible
3 veterans under chapter 17 of title 38, United States Code.

4 (b) TERMS OF AGREEMENT.—Under the agreement
5 under subsection (a), the Secretary of Veterans Affairs
6 shall furnish staffing for the outpatient clinic and the
7 Olympic Medical Center shall furnish facilities and sup-
8 plies for the clinic. The agreement shall (subject to sub-
9 section (c)) provide for payment by the Secretary to the
10 center for expenses related to the furnishing of such facili-
11 ties and services, at a rate to be determined under the
12 agreement.

13 (c) AGREEMENT SUBJECT TO FUNDING.—The agree-
14 ment under subsection (a) shall provide that any require-
15 ment under the agreement for the United States to reim-
16 burse the Olympic Medical Center for any costs or other-
17 wise to make any payments shall be subject to the avail-
18 ability of appropriations for that purpose.
