Mr. FORTENBERRY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To amend the Clean Air Act to exclude agricultural particulates from the national ambient air quality standards for particulate matter, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXCLUSION OF AGRICULTURAL PARTICULATES**

4 **FROM NAAQS FOR PM.**

5 Section 109 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7409)
6 is amended by adding the following new subsection at the
7 end thereof:

8 “(d) No national ambient air quality standard pre-
9 scribed after January 1, 2006, for particulate matter

1 other than fine particulate matter, shall apply to any am-
2 bient mix of particulate matter the majority of which is
3 rural windblown dust and soils and particulate matter gen-
4 erated by agricultural sources. For the purposes of this
5 subsection, the term ‘agricultural sources’ means crop pro-
6 duction and animal production within the meaning of the
7 United States Bureau of Census North American Industry
8 Classification System.”.
