

In the Senate of the United States,

November 8, 2005.

Resolved, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 797) entitled “An Act to amend the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 and other Acts to improve housing programs for Indians.”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENTS:

- 1 **(1)**Page 3, line 14, strike out [and]

- 2 **(2)**Page 3, strike out line 24 and all that follows through
3 page 4, line 4 and insert the following: *of 1968 (42 U.S.C.*
4 *3601 et seq.); and*
5 *(E) federally recognized Indian tribes exercising*
6 *powers of self-government are governed by the Indian*
7 *Civil Rights Act (25 U.S.C. 1301 et seq.); and*

- 8 **(3)**Page 4, strike out line 19 and all that follows through
9 page 5, line 10 and insert the following:

1 **“SEC. 544. INDIAN TRIBES.**

2 *“Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (42 U.S.C.*
3 *2000d et seq.) and title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968*
4 *(42 U.S.C. 3601 et seq.) shall not apply to actions by feder-*
5 *ally recognized Indian tribes (including instrumentalities*
6 *of such Indian tribes) under this Act.”.*

7 **(4)**Page 6, after line 2, insert:

8 **SEC. 6. YOUTHBUILD ELIGIBILITY.**

9 *Section 460 of the Cranston-Gonzalez National Afford-*
10 *able Housing Act (42 U.S.C. 12899h-1) is amended by*
11 *striking “for fiscal year 1998 and fiscal years thereafter”*
12 *and inserting “for fiscal years 1998 through 2005”.*
