**AN ACT**

To make technical corrections to the United States Code.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE.**

4        The purpose of this Act is to make technical correc-  
5 tions to the United States Code relating to cross ref-  
6 erences, typographical errors, and stylistic matters.

7 **SEC. 2. TITLE 10, UNITED STATES CODE.**

8        In section 2701(i)(1) of title 10, United States Code,  
9 in the paragraph catchline, strike “MILLER ACT” and sub-  
10 stitute “SECTIONS 3131 AND 3133 OF TITLE 40”.

1 **SEC. 3. TITLE 23, UNITED STATES CODE.**

2 Title 23, United States Code, is amended as follows:

3 (1) In section 107(a), strike “the Act of Feb-  
4 ruary 26, 1931, 46 Stat. 1421” and substitute “sec-  
5 tions 3114 to 3116 and 3118 of title 40”.

6 (2) In section 210(e), strike “the Act of Feb-  
7 ruary 26, 1931; 46 Stat. 1421” and substitute “sec-  
8 tions 3114 to 3116 and 3118 of title 40”.

9 **SEC. 4. TITLE 28, UNITED STATES CODE.**

10 Title 28, United States Code, is amended as follows:

11 (1) In the analysis for chapter 91, in the item  
12 related to section 1499, strike “Contract Work  
13 Hours and Safety Standards Act” and substitute  
14 “chapter 37 of title 40”.

15 (2) In section 1499, in the section heading,  
16 strike “**CONTRACT WORK HOURS AND SAFETY**  
17 **STANDARDS ACT**” and substitute “**CHAPTER 37**  
18 **OF TITLE 40**”.

19 **SEC. 5. TITLE 36, UNITED STATES CODE.**

20 Title 36, United States Code, is amended as follows:

21 (1) In the analysis for chapter 5, after the item  
22 related to section 509, insert the following:

“510. Disclosure of and prohibition on certain donations.”.

23 (2) In the analysis for chapter 5, in the last  
24 item, which is related to “Authorization of appro-  
25 priations”, strike “510” and substitute “511”.

1           (3) In the analysis for chapter 23, in the item  
2 related to section 2306, strike “museum” and sub-  
3 stitute “Museum”.

4           (4) In section 2301, in the first sentence, strike  
5 “United State Government” and substitute “United  
6 States Government”.

7           (5) In section 20908(c), strike “board or direc-  
8 tors” and substitute “board of directors”.

9           (6) In section 40103(13), strike “laws of the  
10 each State” and substitute “laws of each State”.

11           (7) In section 70912(b), strike “Corporation”  
12 and substitute “corporation”.

13           (8) In section 150511(b), strike “with sec-  
14 retary” and substitute “with the secretary”.

15           (9) In section 151303(c), strike “The Chair-  
16 man” and substitute “The chairman”.

17           (10) In section 153513(a)(1), strike “(16  
18 U.S.C. 1 et seq.), known as the National Park Serv-  
19 ice Organic Act))” and substitute “(16 U.S.C. 1 et  
20 seq.) (known as the National Park Service Organic  
21 Act)”.

22           (11) In section 220104(a)(2)(B), strike “State”  
23 and substitute “Defense”.

1 (12) In the analysis for chapter 2205, in the  
2 item related to section 220501, strike “Definitions.”  
3 and substitute “Short title and definitions.”.

4 (13) In section 220501, in the section heading,  
5 strike “**TITLE AND DEFINITIONS**” and substitute  
6 “**SHORT TITLE AND DEFINITIONS**”.

7 (14) In section 220501(a), in the subsection  
8 catchline, strike “TITLE” and substitute “SHORT  
9 TITLE”.

10 (15) In section 220505(b)(9), strike “this Act”  
11 and substitute “this chapter”.

12 (16) In section 220506(d)(3)(A), strike “sub-  
13 sections” and substitute “subsection”.

14 (17) In section 220509(b)(1)(A), strike “a” be-  
15 fore “paralympic sports organizations”.

16 (18) In section 220511, in the section heading,  
17 strike “**ANNUAL REPORT**” and substitute “**RE-**  
18 **PORT**”.

19 (19) In section 220512, strike “Corporation”  
20 and substitute “corporation”.

21 (20) In section 220521(a), strike “subsections”  
22 and substitute “subsection”.

23 **SEC. 6. TITLE 40, UNITED STATES CODE.**

24 Title 40, United States Code, is amended as follows:

25 (1) In section 522(a), strike “of this section”.

1           (2) In section 522(b), in the subsection catch-  
2 line, strike “AT” and substitute “AT”.

3           (3) In section 552(a), strike “(a) AUTHORITY  
4 TO TAKE PROPERTY Administrator” and substitute  
5 “(a) AUTHORITY TO TAKE PROPERTY.—The Ad-  
6 ministrator”.

7           (4) In section 554(c), in the subsection catch-  
8 line, strike “TRANSPORTATION.” and substitute  
9 “TRANSPORTATION.—”.

10          (5) In section 581(b), strike “The Adminis-  
11 trator may—” and substitute “The Administrator of  
12 General Services may—”.

13          (6) In section 593(b), strike “available to the  
14 Administration” and substitute “available to the  
15 General Services Administration”.

16          (7) In section 611—

17               (A) after “under section 1343, 1344, or  
18 1349(b)”, insert “of title 31”; and

19               (B) after “under section 641”, insert “of  
20 title 18”.

21          (8) In section 3131(e), in the subsection catch-  
22 line, strike “TO” and substitute “TO”.

23          (9) In section 3133(b), in the subsection catch-  
24 line, strike “TO” and substitute “TO”.

1           (10) In section 3133(c), strike “(c) A waiver”  
2 and substitute “(c) WAIVER OF RIGHT TO CIVIL AC-  
3 TION.—A waiver”.

4           (11) In section 3141(1), strike “1494” and  
5 substitute “1494”.

6           (12) In section 3142(d), after “amount referred  
7 to in section 3141(2)(B)”, insert “of this title”.

8           (13) In section 3142(e), after “determined  
9 under section 3141(2)(B)”, insert “of this title”.

10          (14) In section 3701(b)(3)(B)—

11           (A) in the subparagraph catchline, strike  
12 “3902” and substitute “3702”;

13           (B) strike “3902” and substitute “3702”;  
14 and

15           (C) strike “subsection (a)(2)(C)” and sub-  
16 stitute “paragraph (1)(B)(iii)”.

17          (15) In section 3702(d), in the subsection  
18 catchline, strike “TO” and substitute “To”.

19          (16) In section 3704(a)(1), after “authorized by  
20 section 553”, insert “of title 5”.

21          (17) In section 3704(a)(2), strike “of this sec-  
22 tion”.

23          (18) In section 6111(b), in the subsection  
24 catchline, strike the second period.

1           (19) In the analysis for chapter 65, in the first  
2 item, which is related to “Definition”, strike “6581”  
3 and substitute “6501”.

4           (20) In the analysis for chapter 67, in the item  
5 related to subchapter I, strike “ASSIGNMENT” and  
6 substitute “ASSIGNMENT”.

7           (21) In chapter 67, in the heading for sub-  
8 chapter I, strike “ASSIGNMENT” and substitute  
9 “ASSIGNMENT”.

10          (22) In section 8104(b), strike “Commission on  
11 Fine Arts” and substitute “Commission of Fine  
12 Arts”.

13          (23) In section 8105, strike “post-office” and  
14 substitute “post office”.

15          (24) In section 8501(b)(1)(A), after “sections  
16 5101 and 5102”, insert “of this title”.

17          (25) In section 8502(a), strike “5314” and sub-  
18 stitute “5315”.

19          (26) In section 8502(c)(2), after “sections 5101  
20 and 5102”, insert “of this title”.

21          (27) In section 8711(a), after “sections 5101  
22 and 5102”, insert “of this title”.

23          (28) In section 8712(a)(2), after “sections 5101  
24 and 5102”, insert “of this title”.

25          (29) In section 8722(d)—

1 (A) strike “52 Stat. 802” and substitute  
2 “52 Stat. 797”; and

3 (B) strike “is subject” and substitute “are  
4 subject”.

5 (30) In section 9302(b), in the subsection  
6 catchline, strike “WITH” and substitute “WITH”.

7 (31) In section 14308(b)(2), strike “section  
8 (a)(2)” and substitute “subsection (a)(2)”.

9 (32) In section 17504(b), in the subsection  
10 catchline, strike “WITH” and substitute “WITH”.
