1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TIME PERIODS FOR ISSUING CITATIONS.**

4 Section 9 of the Occupational Safety and Health Act
5 of 1970 (29 U.S.C. 658) is amended by striking “with
6 reasonable promptness” and inserting “within thirty
7 working days”. Section 10 of such Act (29 U.S.C. 659)
8 is amended by striking “within a reasonable time” and
9 inserting “within thirty days”.
