## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 8) to make the repeal of the estate tax permanent.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
3 8) to make the repeal of the estate tax permanent. The  
4 bill shall be considered as read. The previous question  
5 shall be considered as ordered on the bill and on any  
6 amendment thereto to final passage without intervening  
7 motion except: (1) one hour of debate on the bill equally

1 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-  
2 nority member of the Committee on Ways and Means; (2)  
3 the amendment in nature of a substitute printed in the  
4 report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this reso-  
5 lution, if offered by Representative Pomeroy of North Da-  
6 kota or his designee, which shall be in order without inter-  
7 vention of any point of order, shall be considered as read,  
8 and shall be separately debatable for one hour equally di-  
9 vided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent;  
10 and (3) one motion to recommit with or without instruc-  
11 tions.
