Mr. SESSIONS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1185) to reform the Federal deposit insurance system, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1185) to reform the Federal deposit
6 insurance system, and for other purposes. The first read-
7 ing of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order
8 against consideration of the bill are waived. General de-

1 bate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one
2 hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman and
3 ranking minority member of the Committee on Financial
4 Services. After general debate the bill shall be considered
5 for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in
6 order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of
7 amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment in
8 the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee
9 on Financial Services now printed in the bill. Each section
10 of the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute
11 shall be considered as read. During consideration of the
12 bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of
13 the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the basis
14 of whether the Member offering an amendment has caused
15 it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional Record
16 designated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII.
17 Amendments so printed shall be considered as read. At
18 the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment
19 the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House
20 with such amendments as may have been adopted. Any
21 Member may demand a separate vote in the House on any
22 amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the
23 bill or to the committee amendment in the nature of a
24 substitute. The previous question shall be considered as
25 ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final pas-

- 1 sage without intervening motion except one motion to re-
- 2 commit with or without instructions.
