Mr. LINCOLN DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2419) making appropriations for energy and water development for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2419) making appropriations for

1 energy and water development for the fiscal year ending  
2 September 30, 2006, and for other purposes. The first  
3 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of  
4 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General  
5 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed  
6 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman  
7 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appro-  
8 priations. After general debate the bill shall be considered  
9 for amendment under the five-minute rule. Points of order  
10 against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with  
11 clause 2 of rule XXI are waived except for section 104.  
12 Where points of order are waived against part of a para-  
13 graph, points of order against a provision in another part  
14 of such paragraph may be made only against such provi-  
15 sion and not against the entire paragraph. During consid-  
16 eration of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the  
17 Committee of the Whole may accord priority in recognition  
18 on the basis of whether the Member offering an amend-  
19 ment has caused it to be printed in the portion of the Con-  
20 gressional Record designated for that purpose in clause  
21 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be consid-  
22 ered as read. When the committee rises and reports the  
23 bill back to the House with a recommendation that the  
24 bill do pass, the previous question shall be considered as  
25 ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final pas-

- 1 sage without intervening motion except one motion to re-
- 2 commit with or without instructions.
