## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2528) making appropriations for military quality of life functions of the Department of Defense, military construction, the Department of Veterans Affairs, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006, and for other purposes.

- 1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
- 3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
2 ation of the bill (H.R. 2528) making appropriations for  
3 military quality of life functions of the Department of De-  
4 fense, military construction, the Department of Veterans  
5 Affairs, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending  
6 September 30, 2006, and for other purposes. The first  
7 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of  
8 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General  
9 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed  
10 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman  
11 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appro-  
12 priations. After general debate the bill shall be considered  
13 for amendment under the five-minute rule. Points of order  
14 against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with  
15 clause 2 of rule XXI are waived. During consideration of  
16 the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee  
17 of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the  
18 basis of whether the Member offering an amendment has  
19 caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional  
20 Record designated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule  
21 XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered as  
22 read. When the committee rises and reports the bill back  
23 to the House with a recommendation that the bill do pass,  
24 the previous question shall be considered as ordered on  
25 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without

- 1 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
- 2 or without instructions.
