Mr. GINGREY, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 10) proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States authorizing the Congress to prohibit the physical desecration of the flag of the United States.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the joint resolution (H.J.
4 Res. 10) proposing an amendment to the Constitution of
5 the United States authorizing the Congress to prohibit the

1 physical desecration of the flag of the United States. The
2 joint resolution shall be considered as read. The previous
3 question shall be considered as ordered on the joint resolu-
4 tion and on any amendment thereto to final passage with-
5 out intervening motion except: (1) two hours of debate on
6 the joint resolution equally divided and controlled by the
7 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
8 on the Judiciary; (2) the amendment in the nature of a
9 substitute printed in the report of the Committee on Rules
10 accompanying this resolution, if offered by Representative
11 Watt of North Carolina or his designee, which shall be
12 in order without intervention of any point of order, shall
13 be considered as read, and shall be separately debatable
14 for one hour equally divided and controlled by the pro-
15 ponent and an opponent; and (3) one motion to recommit
16 with or without instructions.

17 SEC. 2. During consideration of H.J. Res. 10 pursu-
18 ant to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation of the
19 previous question, the Chair may postpone further consid-
20 eration of the joint resolution to a time designated by the
21 Speaker.
