RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the resolution (H. Res. 571) expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that the deployment of United States forces in Iraq be terminated immediately and providing for consideration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 308) directing the Clerk of the House of Representatives to make a technical correction in the enrollment of H.R. 3058.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order without intervention of any point of order
3 to consider in the House the resolution (H. Res. 571) ex-
4 pressing the sense of the House of Representatives that
5 the deployment of United States forces in Iraq be termi-
6 nated immediately. The resolution shall be considered as
7 read. The previous question shall be considered as ordered
8 on the resolution to final adoption without intervening mo-
9 tion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
10 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member
11 of the Committee on International Relations; and (2) one
12 motion to recommit which may not contain instructions.

13 SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution, House Con-
14 current Resolution 308 is hereby adopted.
