RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4297) to provide for reconciliation pursuant to section 201(b) of the concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year 2006.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 4297) to
4 provide for reconciliation pursuant to section 201(b) of the
5 concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year 2006.
6 The bill shall be considered as read. The amendment in
7 the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee

1 on Ways and Means now printed in the bill shall be consid-
2 ered as adopted. The previous question shall be considered
3 as ordered on the bill, as amended, to final passage with-
4 out intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate on
5 the bill, as amended, equally divided and controlled by the
6 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
7 on Ways and Means; (2) the amendment in the nature
8 of a substitute printed in the report of the Committee on
9 Rules accompanying this resolution, if offered by Rep-
10 resentative Rangel of New York or his designee, which
11 shall be in order without intervention of any point of
12 order, shall be considered as read, and shall be separately
13 debatable for one hour equally divided and controlled by
14 the proponent and an opponent; and (3) one motion to
15 recommit with or without instructions.
