# RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4167) to amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act to provide for uniform food safety warning notification requirements, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4167) to amend the Federal Food,  
6 Drug, and Cosmetic Act to provide for uniform food safety

1 warning notification requirements, and for other purposes.  
2 The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All  
3 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived.  
4 General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not  
5 exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the  
6 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee  
7 on Energy and Commerce. After general debate the Com-  
8 mittee of the Whole shall rise without motion. No further  
9 consideration of the bill shall be in order except pursuant  
10 to a subsequent order of the House.
