Mr. BISHOP of Utah, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 609) to amend and extend the Higher Education Act of 1965.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 609) to amend and extend the  
6 Higher Education Act of 1965. The first reading of the  
7 bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against

1 consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall  
2 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-  
3 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-  
4 nority member of the Committee on Education and the  
5 Workforce. After general debate the bill shall be consid-  
6 ered for amendment under the five-minute rule. In lieu  
7 of the amendment recommended by the Committee on  
8 Education and the Workforce now printed in the bill, it  
9 shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the  
10 purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule an  
11 amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the  
12 text of the Rules Committee Print dated March 22, 2006.  
13 That amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be  
14 considered as read. All points of order against that amend-  
15 ment in the nature of a substitute are waived. Notwith-  
16 standing clause 11 of rule XVIII, no amendment to that  
17 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be in order  
18 except those printed in the report of the Committee on  
19 Rules accompanying this resolution. Each such amend-  
20 ment may be offered only in the order printed in the re-  
21 port, may be offered only by a Member designated in the  
22 report, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for  
23 the time specified in the report equally divided and con-  
24 trolled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be  
25 subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a de-

1 mand for division of the question in the House or in the  
2 Committee of the Whole. All points of order against such  
3 amendments are waived. After disposition of the amend-  
4 ments printed in the report of the Committee on Rules,  
5 the Committee of the Whole shall rise without motion. No  
6 further consideration of the bill shall be in order except  
7 pursuant to a subsequent order of the House.
