Mr. TOM DAVIS of Virginia (for himself, Mr. ISSA, Mr. WEXLER, Mr. WILSON of South Carolina, Mr. BAIRD, Mr. McDERMOTT, and Ms. WATSON) submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on International Relations

RESOLUTION

Condemning in the strongest terms the terrorist attacks in Dahab and Northern Sinai, Egypt, on April 24 and 26, 2006.

Whereas, on April 24 and 26, 2006, a series of explosions at Dahab and in Northern Sinai, Egypt, planned and carried out by terrorists, resulted in the deaths of scores of civilians and the injury of many others;

Whereas the people of Egypt have been subjected to several other deadly terrorist attacks over the past years; and

Whereas President George W. Bush called President Hosni Mubarak of Egypt to extend condolences on behalf of the American people for the loss of life: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives—

2 (1) condemns in the strongest terms the ter-
3 rorist attacks on Dahab and Northern Sinai, Egypt
4 and other terrorist attacks directed against Egypt;

5 (2) expresses its condolences to the families and
6 friends of those individuals who were killed in the
7 attacks and expresses its sympathies to those indi-
8 viduals who have been injured;

9 (3) joins with President George W. Bush in ex-
10 pressing the solidarity of the people and Government
11 of the United States with the people and Govern-
12 ment of Egypt as they recover from these cowardly
13 and inhuman attacks; and

14 (4) expresses its readiness to support the Egyp-
15 tian authorities in their efforts to bring to justice
16 those individuals responsible for the recent attacks
17 in Egypt and to pursue, disrupt, undermine, and
18 dismantle the networks which plan and carry out
19 such attacks.
