Mr. PUTNAM, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for further consideration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 376) establishing the congressional budget for the United States Government for fiscal year 2007 and setting forth appropriate budgetary levels for fiscal years 2008 through 2011.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for further
5 consideration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res.

1 376) establishing the congressional budget for the United
2 States Government for fiscal year 2007 and setting forth
3 appropriate budgetary levels for fiscal years 2008 through
4 2011. The amendments printed in part A of the report
5 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution
6 shall be considered as adopted in the House and in the
7 Committee of the Whole. The concurrent resolution, as
8 amended, shall be considered as read. No further amend-
9 ment shall be in order except those printed in part B of
10 the report of the Committee on Rules. Each amendment
11 may be offered only in the order printed in the report,
12 may be offered only by a Member designated in the report,
13 shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for 40 min-
14 utes equally divided and controlled by the proponent and
15 an opponent, and shall not be subject to amendment. All
16 points of order against the amendments printed in the re-
17 port are waived except that the adoption of an amendment
18 in the nature of a substitute shall constitute the conclusion
19 of consideration of the concurrent resolution for amend-
20 ment. After the conclusion of consideration of the concur-
21 rent resolution for amendment and a final period of gen-
22 eral debate, which shall not exceed 20 minutes equally di-
23 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-
24 ity member of the Committee on the Budget, the Com-
25 mittee shall rise and report the concurrent resolution, as

1 amended, to the House with such further amendment as
2 may have been adopted. The previous question shall be
3 considered as ordered on the concurrent resolution and
4 amendments thereto to final adoption without intervening
5 motion except amendments offered by the chairman of the
6 Committee on the Budget pursuant to section 305(a)(5)
7 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 to achieve math-
8 ematical consistency. The concurrent resolution shall not
9 be subject to a demand for division of the question of its
10 adoption.

11 SEC. 2. After adoption of House Concurrent Resolu-
12 tion 376, it shall be in order to take from the Speaker's
13 table Senate Concurrent Resolution 83 and to consider the
14 Senate concurrent resolution in the House. All points of
15 order against consideration of the Senate concurrent reso-
16 lution are waived. It shall be in order to move to strike
17 all after the resolving clause of the Senate concurrent res-
18 olution and to insert in lieu thereof the provisions of
19 House Concurrent Resolution 376 as adopted by the
20 House. All points of order against that motion are waived.
21 If the motion is adopted and the Senate concurrent resolu-
22 tion, as amended, is adopted, then it shall be in order to
23 move that the House insist on its amendment to the Sen-
24 ate concurrent resolution and request a conference with
25 the Senate thereon.
