Mr. GINGREY, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5385) making appropriations for the military quality of life functions of the Department of Defense, military construction, the Department of Veterans Affairs, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007, and for other purposes.

- 1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
- 3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the State of the Union for consid-
2 eration of the bill (H.R. 5385) making appropriations for
3 the military quality of life functions of the Department
4 of Defense, military construction, the Department of Vet-
5 erans Affairs, and related agencies for the fiscal year end-
6 ing September 30, 2007, and for other purposes. The first
7 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of
8 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General
9 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed
10 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman
11 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appro-
12 priations. After general debate the bill shall be considered
13 for amendment under the five-minute rule. Points of order
14 against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with
15 clause 2 of rule XXI are waived except for title IV. During
16 consideration of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of
17 the Committee of the Whole may accord priority in recogni-
18 tion on the basis of whether the Member offering an
19 amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion of
20 the Congressional Record designated for that purpose in
21 clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be
22 considered as read. When the committee rises and reports
23 the bill back to the House with a recommendation that
24 the bill do pass, the previous question shall be considereed
25 as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final

- 1 passage without intervening motion except one motion to
- 2 recommit with or without instructions.
