Mr. SESSIONS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

---

# RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5441) making appropriations for the Department of Homeland Security for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 5441) making appropriations for  
6 the Department of Homeland Security for the fiscal year

1 ending September 30, 2007, and for other purposes. The  
2 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points  
3 of order against consideration of the bill are waived. Gen-  
4 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-  
5 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair-  
6 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on  
7 Appropriations. After general debate the bill shall be con-  
8 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. Points  
9 of order against provisions in the bill for failure to comply  
10 with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived except: beginning  
11 with the comma on page 38, line 11 through “funds” on  
12 line 14; section 512; beginning with “or” on page 54, line  
13 12 through “appropriation” on line 13; and section 536.  
14 Where points of order are waived against part of a para-  
15 graph or section, points of order against a provision in  
16 another part of such paragraph or section may be made  
17 only against such provision and not against the entire  
18 paragraph or section. During consideration of the bill for  
19 amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole  
20 may accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether  
21 the Member offering an amendment has caused it to be  
22 printed in the portion of the Congressional Record des-  
23 ignated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amend-  
24 ments so printed shall be considered as read. When the  
25 committee rises and reports the bill back to the House

1 with a recommendation that the bill do pass, the previous  
2 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and  
3 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening  
4 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-  
5 structions.
