RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 88) proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States relating to marriage.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the joint resolution (H.J.
4 Res. 88) proposing an amendment to the Constitution of
5 the United States relating to marriage. The joint resolu-
6 tion shall be considered as read. The previous question
7 shall be considered as ordered on the joint resolution to

1 final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one
2 hour and 30 minutes of debate equally divided and con-
3 trolled by the Majority Leader and the Minority Leader
4 or their designees; and (2) one motion to recommit.

5 SEC. 2. During consideration of H.J. Res. 88 pursu-
6 ant to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation of the
7 previous question, the Chair may postpone further consid-
8 eration of the joint resolution to a time designated by the
9 Speaker.
