RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1956) to regulate certain State taxation of interstate commerce; and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 1956) to
4 regulate certain State taxation of interstate commerce;
5 and for other purposes. The amendment in the nature of
6 a substitute recommended by the Committee on the Judi-
7 ciary now printed in the bill shall be considered as adopt-

1 ed. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. The
2 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
3 bill, as amended, to final passage without intervening mo-
4 tion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
5 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member
6 of the Committee on the Judiciary; and (2) one motion
7 to recommit with or without instructions.
