Mr. BISHOP of Utah, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5682) to exempt from certain requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 a proposed nuclear agreement for cooperation with India.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 5682) to exempt from certain re-

1 requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 a proposed  
2 nuclear agreement for cooperation with India. The first  
3 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of  
4 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General  
5 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed  
6 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman  
7 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Inter-  
8 national Relations. After general debate the bill shall be  
9 considered for amendment under the five-minute rule. The  
10 amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by  
11 the Committee on International Relations now printed in  
12 the bill, modified by the amendment printed in part A of  
13 the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this  
14 resolution, shall be considered as adopted in the House  
15 and in the Committee of the Whole. The bill, as amended,  
16 shall be considered as the original bill for the purpose of  
17 further amendment and shall be considered as read. Not-  
18 withstanding clause 11 of rule XVIII, no further amend-  
19 ment to the bill, as amended, shall be in order except those  
20 printed in part B of the report of the Committee on Rules.  
21 Each such amendment may be offered only in the order  
22 printed in the report, may be offered only by a Member  
23 designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall  
24 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally  
25 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,

1 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be sub-  
2 ject to a demand for division of the question in the House  
3 or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of order  
4 against such amendments are waived. At the conclusion  
5 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee  
6 shall rise and report the bill, as amended, to the House  
7 with such further amendments as may have been adopted.  
8 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on  
9 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without  
10 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with  
11 or without instructions.
