## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 310) to increase the penalties for violations by television and radio broadcasters of the prohibitions against transmission of obscene, indecent, and profane material, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of  
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 310) to in-  
4 crease the penalties for violations by television and radio  
5 broadcasters of the prohibitions against transmission of

1 obscene, indecent, and profane material, and for other  
2 purposes. The bill shall be considered as read. The pre-  
3 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill  
4 and on any amendment thereto to final passage without  
5 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate on the  
6 bill equally divided and controlled by the chairman and  
7 ranking minority member of the Committee on Energy  
8 and Commerce; (2) an amendment printed in the report  
9 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution,  
10 if offered by Representative Upton of Michigan or his des-  
11 ignee, which shall be in order without intervention of any  
12 point of order or demand for division of the question, shall  
13 be considered as read, and shall be separately debatable  
14 for 20 minutes equally divided and controlled by the pro-  
15 ponent and an opponent; and (3) one motion to recommit  
16 with or without instructions.
