1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the bill (S. 5) to amend
4 the procedures that apply to consideration of interstate
5 class actions to assure fairer outcomes for class members
6 and defendants, and for other purposes. The bill shall be

1 considered as read. The previous question shall be consid-
2 ered as ordered on the bill and on any amendment thereto
3 to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) 90
4 minutes of debate on the bill equally divided and controlled
5 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the
6 Committee on the Judiciary; (2) the amendment in the
7 nature of a substitute printed in the report of the Com-
8 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution, if offered
9 by Representative Conyers of Michigan or his designee,
10 which shall be in order without intervention of any point
11 of order, shall be considered as read, and shall be sepa-
12 rately debatable for 40 minutes equally divided and con-
13 trolled by the proponent and an opponent; and (3) one
14 motion to commit with or without instructions.
