## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the printing of a commemorative document in memory of the late President of the United States, Gerald Rudolph Ford.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. COMMEMORATIVE DOCUMENT AUTHORIZED.**

4        (a) IN GENERAL.—A commemorative document in  
5 memory of the late President of the United States, Gerald  
6 Rudolph Ford, shall be printed as a House document, with

1 illustrations and suitable binding, under the direction of  
2 the Joint Committee on Printing.

3 (b) CONTENTS.—The document shall consist of the  
4 eulogies and encomiums for Gerald Rudolph Ford, as ex-  
5 pressed in the Senate and the House of Representatives,  
6 together with the texts of each of the following:

7 (1) The funeral ceremony at Palm Desert, Cali-  
8 fornia.

9 (2) The state funeral ceremony at the rotunda  
10 of the United States Capitol.

11 (3) The national funeral service held at the  
12 Washington National Cathedral in the District of  
13 Columbia.

14 (4) The interment ceremony at the Gerald Ford  
15 Presidential Museum, Grand Rapids, Michigan.

16 **SEC. 2. PRINTING OF DOCUMENT.**

17 In addition to the usual number of copies printed of  
18 the commemorative document under section 1, there shall  
19 be printed the lesser of—

20 (1) 32,500 copies, of which 22,150 copies shall  
21 be for the use of the House of Representatives and  
22 10,350 copies shall be for the use of the Senate; or

23 (2) such number of copies that does not exceed  
24 a production and printing cost of \$600,000, with

- 1 distribution of the copies to be allocated in the same
- 2 proportion as described in paragraph (1).
