## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-  
3 tive day of Wednesday, January 23, 2008, on a motion  
4 offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution by its Ma-  
5 jority Leader or his designee, it stand adjourned until 2  
6 p.m. on Monday, January 28, 2008, or until the time of  
7 any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of this

1 concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first; and that  
2 when the House adjourns on the legislative day of Tues-  
3 day, January 29, 2008, on a motion offered pursuant to  
4 this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his  
5 designee, it stand adjourned until 2 p.m. on Wednesday,  
6 February 6, 2008, or until the time of any reassembly pur-  
7 suant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever  
8 occurs first.

9       SEC. 2. The Speaker or her designee, after consulta-  
10 tion with the Minority Leader, shall notify the Members  
11 of the House to reassemble at such place and time as she  
12 may designate if, in her opinion, the public interest shall  
13 warrant it.
