## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To make technical corrections in the enrollment of the bill  
H.R. 493.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That in the enrollment of the bill H.R. 493  
3 (to prohibit discrimination on the basis of genetic informa-  
4 tion with respect to health insurance and employment) the  
5 Clerk of the House of Representatives shall make the fol-  
6 lowing technical corrections:

7            (1) In section 104(d)—

1 (A) in paragraph (2), strike “June 30,  
2 2008” and insert “October 31, 2008”;

3 (B) in paragraph (3), strike “October 1,  
4 2008” and insert “July 1, 2009”; and

5 (C) in paragraph (4)—

6 (i) in subparagraph (A)(ii), strike  
7 “October 1, 2008” and insert “July 1,  
8 2009”; and

9 (ii) in subparagraph (B)(ii)—

10 (I) strike “in 2008” and insert  
11 “in 2009”; and

12 (II) strike “July 1, 2008” and  
13 insert “July 1, 2009”.

14 (2) In section 202(b)(6), strike “law enforce-  
15 ment” and all that follows through “and requests”  
16 and insert “law enforcement purposes as a forensic  
17 laboratory or for purposes of human remains identi-  
18 fication, and requests”.

19 (3) In section 205(b)(6), strike “law enforce-  
20 ment” and all that follows through “and requests”  
21 and insert “law enforcement purposes as a forensic

1 laboratory or for purposes of human remains identifica-  
2 tion, and requests”.
