JOINT RESOLUTION

Approving the renewal of import restrictions contained in the Burmese Freedom and Democracy Act of 2003, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*

2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RENEWAL OF IMPORT RESTRICTIONS UNDER**

4 **BURMESE FREEDOM AND DEMOCRACY ACT**

5 **OF 2003.**

1 Congress approves the renewal of import restrictions
2 contained in section 3(a)(1) of the Burmese Freedom and
3 Democracy Act of 2003.

4 **SEC. 2. MERCHANDISE PROCESSING FEES.**

5 Section 13031(j)(3)(A) of the Consolidated Omnibus
6 Budget Reconciliation Act of 1985 (19 U.S.C.
7 58c(j)(3)(A)) is amended by striking “October 14, 2014”
8 and inserting “October 21, 2014”.

9 **SEC. 3. TIME FOR PAYMENT OF CORPORATE ESTIMATED**
10 **TAXES.**

11 Subparagraph (B) of section 401(1) of the Tax In-
12 crease Prevention and Reconciliation Act of 2005 is
13 amended by striking “114.50 percent” and inserting
14 “114.75 percent”.

15 **SEC. 4. RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.**

16 This joint resolution shall be deemed to be a “renewal
17 resolution” for purposes of section 9 of the Burmese Free-
18 dom and Democracy Act of 2003.

19 **SEC. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

20 This joint resolution and the amendments made by
21 this joint resolution shall take effect on the date of the

1 enactment of this joint resolution on July 26, 2007, which-
2 ever occurs first.
