A BILL

To prohibit the designation of any agency, bureau, or other entity of the Department of Homeland Security as a separate agency or bureau for purposes of post employment restrictions in title 18, United States Code.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INTEGRITY IN POST-EMPLOYMENT.**

4 (a) DESIGNATIONS AS SEPARATE AGENCIES AND BU-
5 REAUS BARRED.—No agency, bureau, or other entity of
6 the Department of Homeland Security may be designated
7 under section 207(h)(1) of title 18, United States Code,
8 as a separate agency or bureau.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—

2 (1) IN GENERAL.—This section takes effect on
3 the date of the enactment of this Act.

4 (2) APPLICABILITY TO DESIGNATIONS.—The
5 following shall cease to be effective on the date of
6 the enactment of this Act:

7 (A) Any waiver of restrictions made under
8 section 207(c)(2)(C) of title 18, United States
9 Code, before the enactment of this Act, with re-
10 spect to any position, or category of positions,
11 in the Department of Homeland Security.

12 (B) Any designation of an agency, bureau,
13 or other entity in the Department of Homeland
14 Security, before the enactment of this Act,
15 under section 207(h)(1) of title 18, United
16 States Code, as a separate agency or bureau.
