## A BILL

To temporarily extend the programs under the Higher Education Act of 1965, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “First Higher Edu-  
5 cation Extension Act of 2007”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PROGRAMS.**

7 Section 2(a) of the Higher Education Extension Act  
8 of 2005 (Public Law 109–81; 20 U.S.C. 1001 note) is  
9 amended by striking “June 30, 2007” and inserting “Oc-  
10 tober 31, 2007”.

1 **SEC. 3. RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.**

2       Nothing in this Act, or in the Higher Education Ex-  
3 tension Act of 2005 as amended by this Act, shall be con-  
4 strued to limit or otherwise alter the authorizations of ap-  
5 propriations for, or the durations of, programs contained  
6 in the amendments made by the Higher Education Rec-  
7 onciliation Act of 2005 (Public Law 109–171) to the pro-  
8 visions of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and the Tax-  
9 payer-Teacher Protection Act of 2004.
