3 **SECTION 1. LANCE CORPORAL DAVID K. FRIBLEY POST OF-**
4 **FICE.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 216 East Main Street in Atwood,
7 Indiana, shall be known and designated as the “Lance
8 Corporal David K. Fribley Post Office”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the “Lance Corporal David
5 K. Fribley Post Office”.
