A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to carry out a study to determine the suitability and feasibility of establishing a historic district to the Camp Hale on parcels of land in the State of Colorado.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 *This Act may be cited as the “Camp Hale Study Act”.*

3 **SEC. 2. SPECIAL RESOURCE STUDY OF THE SUITABILITY**
4 **AND FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING CAMP**
5 **HALE AS A UNIT OF THE NATIONAL PARK SYS-**
6 **TEM.**

7 *(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior, act-*
8 *ing through the Director of the National Park Service,*
9 *(hereinafter referred to as the “Secretary”) shall complete*
10 *a special resource study of Camp Hale to determine—*

11 *(1) the suitability and feasibility of designating*
12 *Camp Hale as a separate unit of the National Park*
13 *System; and*

14 *(2) the methods and means for the protection*
15 *and interpretation of Camp Hale by the National*
16 *Park Service, other Federal, State, or local govern-*
17 *ment entities or private or nonprofit organizations.*

18 *(b) STUDY REQUIREMENTS.—The Secretary shall con-*
19 *duct the study in accordance with section 8(c) of Public*
20 *Law 91–383 (16 U.S.C. 1a–5).*

21 *(c) REPORT.—Not later than 3 years after the date on*
22 *which funds are made available to carry out this Act, the*
23 *Secretary shall submit to the Committee on Natural Re-*
24 *sources of the House of Representatives and the Committee*
25 *on Energy and Natural Resources of the Senate a report*
26 *containing—*

- 1 (1) *the results of the study; and*
- 2 (2) *any recommendations of the Secretary.*

3 **SEC. 3. EFFECT OF STUDY.**

4 *Nothing in this Act shall affect valid existing rights,*
5 *including—*

- 6 (1) *all interstate water compacts in existence on*
7 *the date of the enactment of this Act (including full*
8 *development of any apportionment made in accord-*
9 *ance with the compacts);*
- 10 (2) *water rights decreed at the Camp Hale site*
11 *or flowing within, below, or through the Camp Hale*
12 *site;*
- 13 (3) *water rights in the State of Colorado;*
- 14 (4) *water rights held by the United States; and*
- 15 (5) *the management and operation of any res-*
16 *ervoir, including the storage, management, release, or*
17 *transportation of water.*

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to direct the Secretary of the Interior to carry out a study to determine the suitability and feasibility of establishing Camp Hale as a unit of the National Park System.”.

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
