CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Directing the President pursuant to section 5(c) of the War Powers Resolution to remove United States Armed Forces from Somalia by January 31, 1994.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. FINDING THAT THE UNITED STATES ARMED**
4 **FORCES IN SOMALIA ARE ENGAGED IN HOS-**
5 **TILITIES.**

6 For purposes of sections 5(c) and 7 of the War Pow-
7 ers Resolution (50 U.S.C. 1544(c) and 1546), the Con-
8 gress finds that the United States Armed Forces in Soma-
9 lia are engaged in hostilities without a declaration of war
10 or specific statutory authorization.

1 **SEC. 2. REMOVAL OF ARMED FORCES FROM SOMALIA.**

2 Pursuant to section 5(c) of the War Powers Resolu-
3 tion (50 U.S.C. 1544(c)), the Congress hereby directs the
4 President to remove the United States Armed Forces from
5 Somalia by January 31, 1994.
