Directing the President pursuant to section 5(c) of the War Powers Resolution to remove United States Armed Forces from Somalia by January 31, 1994.

1 **SECTION 1. FINDING THAT THE UNITED STATES ARMED**
2 **FORCES IN SOMALIA ARE ENGAGED IN HOS-**
3 **TILITIES.**

4 For purposes of sections 5(c) and 7 of the War Pow-
5 ers Resolution (50 U.S.C. 1544(c) and 1546), the Con-
6 gress finds that the United States Armed Forces in Soma-
7 lia are engaged in hostilities without a declaration of war
8 or specific statutory authorization.

9 **SEC. 2. REMOVAL OF ARMED FORCES FROM SOMALIA.**

10 Pursuant to section 5(c) of the War Powers Resolu-
11 tion (50 U.S.C. 1544(c)), the Congress hereby directs the
12 President to remove the United States Armed Forces from
13 Somalia by January 31, 1994.

14 **SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES**
15 **FROM SOMALIA.**

16 *Pursuant to section 5(c) of the War Powers Resolution*
17 *(50 U.S.C. 1544(c)), the Congress hereby directs the Presi-*
18 *dent to remove United States Armed Forces from Somalia*
19 *by March 31, 1994 (unless the President requests and the*
20 *Congress authorizes a later date), except for a limited num-*
21 *ber of members of the Armed Forces sufficient only to pro-*
22 *tect United States diplomatic facilities and citizens, and*
23 *noncombatant personnel to advise the United Nations com-*
24 *mander in Somalia.*

Amend the title so as to read: “Concurrent resolution directing the President pursuant to section 5(c) of the War Powers Resolution to remove United States Armed Forces from Somalia.”.
