Whereas Victoria Van Meter will become the youngest female pilot to make a transatlantic flight;

Whereas the flight of a 12-year-old girl across the ocean will send a positive message to the world;

Whereas Victoria Van Meter exemplifies the positive spirit of the United States;

Whereas Victoria Van Meter will represent the youth of the United States in her world travels; and

Whereas Victoria Van Meter has already been an inspiration to people both young and old: Now, therefore, be it
