CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To correct an error in the enrollment of the bill H.R. 1804.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That in the enrollment of the bill (H.R. 1804)
3 to improve learning and teaching by providing a national
4 framework for education reform; to promote the research,
5 consensus building, and systemic changes needed to en-
6 sure equitable educational opportunities and high levels of
7 educational achievement for all American students; to pro-
8 vide a framework for reauthorization of all Federal edu-
9 cation programs; to promote the development and adop-
10 tion of a voluntary national system of skill standards and
11 certifications; and for other purposes, the Clerk of the
12 House of Representatives shall make the following correc-

1 tion: in section 1043(c)(1), after “within any indoor facil-
2 ity” insert “in the United States”.
