## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the 1994 Special Olympics Torch Relay to be run through the Capitol Grounds.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2        *concurring),*

3        **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF RUNNING OF SPECIAL**  
4                                **OLYMPICS TORCH RELAY THROUGH CAPITOL**  
5                                **GROUND.**

6        On May 20, 1994, or on such other date as the  
7        Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Presi-  
8        dent pro tempore of the Senate may jointly designate, the  
9        1994 Special Olympics Torch Relay may be run through  
10       the Capitol Grounds, as part of the journey of the Special

1 Olympics torch to the District of Columbia Special Olym-  
2 pics summer games at Gallaudet University in the District  
3 of Columbia.

4 **SEC. 2. RESPONSIBILITY OF CAPITOL POLICE BOARD.**

5 The Capitol Police Board shall take such action as  
6 may be necessary to carry out section 1.

7 **SEC. 3. CONDITIONS RELATING TO PHYSICAL PREPARA-**  
8 **TIONS.**

9 The Architect of the Capitol may prescribe conditions  
10 for physical preparations for the event authorized by  
11 section 1.
