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**CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

Authorizing the 1994 Special Olympics Torch Relay to be run through the Capitol Grounds.

1 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF RUNNING OF SPECIAL**  
2 **OLYMPICS TORCH RELAY THROUGH CAPITOL**  
3 **GROUNDS.**

4 On May 20, 1994, or on such other date as the  
5 Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Presi-  
6 dent pro tempore of the Senate may jointly designate, the  
7 1994 Special Olympics Torch Relay may be run through  
8 the Capitol Grounds, as part of the journey of the Special  
9 Olympics torch to the District of Columbia Special Olym-  
10 pics summer games at Gallaudet University in the District  
11 of Columbia.

12 **SEC. 2. RESPONSIBILITY OF CAPITOL POLICE BOARD.**

13 The Capitol Police Board shall take such action as  
14 may be necessary to carry out section 1.

15 **SEC. 3. CONDITIONS RELATING TO PHYSICAL PREPARA-**  
16 **TIONS.**

17 The Architect of the Capitol may prescribe conditions  
18 for physical preparations for the event authorized by  
19 section 1.
