Mr. GEPHARDT submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment or recess of the two Houses.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-  
3 tive day of Thursday, June 30, 1994, it stand adjourned  
4 until 10:30 a.m. on Tuesday, July 12, 1994, or until noon  
5 on the second day after Members are notified to reassem-  
6 ble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,  
7 whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses  
8 or adjourns at the close of business on Thursday, June  
9 30, 1994, Friday, July 1, 1994, Saturday, July 2, 1994,  
10 or Sunday, July 3, 1994, pursuant to a motion made by  
11 the majority leader or his designee, in accordance with this  
12 resolution, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on

1 Monday, July 11, 1994, or at such time on that day as  
2 may be specified by the majority leader or his designee  
3 in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until noon on the  
4 second day after Members are notified to reassemble pur-  
5 suant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever  
6 occurs first.

7       SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the majority  
8 leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with  
9 the minority leader of the House and the minority leader  
10 of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House and  
11 the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in their  
12 opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
