Mr. GEPHARDT submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment or recess of the two Houses

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House is in receipt of a mes-
3 sage that the Senate has agreed to a concurrent resolution
4 providing for the adjournment of the two Houses to noon
5 on Thursday, September 8, 1994, or until noon on the
6 second day after Members are notified to reassemble pur-
7 suant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever
8 occurs first, that the House shall stand adjourned in like
9 manner; and that when the Senate recesses or adjourns
10 at the close of business on Monday, August 22, 1994, or
11 any day thereafter, pursuant to a motion made by the Ma-
12 jority Leader or his designee, in accordance with this reso-

1 lution, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on Thurs-
2 day, September 8, 1994, or until noon on the second day
3 after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to sec-
4 tion 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

5 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
6 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
7 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
8 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
9 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
10 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
