CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment or recess of the two Houses.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House is in receipt of a mes-
3 sage that the Senate has agreed to a concurrent resolution
4 providing for the adjournment of the two Houses to noon
5 on Thursday, September 8, 1994, or until noon on the
6 second day after Members are notified to reassemble pur-
7 suant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever
8 occurs first, that the House shall stand adjourned in like
9 manner; and that when the Senate recesses or adjourns
10 at the close of business on Monday, August 22, 1994, or
11 any day thereafter, pursuant to a motion made by the ma-
12 jority leader or his designee, in accordance with this reso-
13 lution, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on Thurs-

1 day, September 8, 1994, or until noon on the second day
2 after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to sec-
3 tion 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

4 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the majority
5 leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
6 the minority leader of the House and the minority leader
7 of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House and
8 the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in their
9 opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
