Mr. MOAKLEY submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for the printing of a collection of statements made in tribute to the late Speaker of the House of Representatives, Thomas P. “Tip” O’Neill, Jr.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That a collection of statements made in trib-
3 ute to the late Speaker of the House of Representatives,
4 Thomas P. “Tip” O’Neill, Jr., together with related mate-
5 rials, shall be printed as a House document, with illustra-
6 tions and suitable binding. The document shall be pre-
7 pared under the direction of the Joint Committee on
8 Printing.

1 SEC. 2. In addition to the usual number, there shall
2 be printed the lesser of—

3 (1) 5,000 casebound copies of the document, of
4 which 1,760 copies shall be for the use of the House
5 of Representatives, 400 copies shall be for the use
6 of the Senate, and 2,840 copies shall be for the use
7 of the Joint Committee on Printing; or

8 (2) such number of casebound copies of the
9 document as does not exceed a total production and
10 printing cost of \$79,500, with distribution to be allo-
11 cated in the same proportion as described in para-
12 graph (1).
