CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment or recess of the two Houses.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Friday, October 7, 1994, pursuant to a motion
4 made by the majority leader, or his designee, in accord-
5 ance with this concurrent resolution, it stand adjourned
6 until noon on Tuesday, November 29, 1994, or until noon
7 on the second day after Members are notified to reassem-
8 ble pursuant to section 3 of this concurrent resolution,
9 whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate adjourns
10 or recesses at the close of business on any day from Fri-
11 day, October 7, 1994 through Friday, October 14, 1994,
12 pursuant to a motion made by the majority leader, or his
13 designee, in accordance with this concurrent resolution, it

1 stand recessed or adjourned until 9 a.m. on Wednesday,
2 November 30, 1994, or such time on that day as may be
3 specified by the majority leader or his designee in the mo-
4 tion to recess or adjourn, or until noon on the second day
5 after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to sec-
6 tion 3 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

7 SEC. 2. When the House adjourns on the legislative
8 day of Tuesday, November 29, 1994, pursuant to a motion
9 made by the majority leader, or his designee, in accord-
10 ance with this concurrent resolution, it stand adjourned
11 sine die, or until noon on the second day after Members
12 are notified to reassemble pursuant to section 3 of this
13 concurrent resolution; and that when the Senate adjourns
14 at the close of business on Thursday, December 1, 1994,
15 it stand adjourned sine die, or until noon on the second
16 day after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to
17 section 3 of this concurrent resolution.

18 SEC. 3. The Speaker of the House and the majority
19 leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
20 the minority leader of the House and the minority leader
21 of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House and

1 the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in their
2 opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
