CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the 1993 Special Olympics Torch Relay to be
run through the Capitol Grounds.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF RUNNING OF SPECIAL**
4 **OLYMPICS TORCH RELAY THROUGH CAPITOL**
5 **GROUND.**

6 On May 27, 1993, or on such other date as the
7 Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Presi-
8 dent pro tempore of the Senate may designate jointly, the
9 1993 Special Olympics Torch Relay may be run through
10 the Capitol Grounds, as part of the journey of the Special
11 Olympics torch to the District of Columbia Special Olym-
12 pics summer games at Gallaudet University in the District
13 of Columbia.

1 **SEC. 2. RESPONSIBILITY OF CAPITOL POLICE BOARD.**

2 The Capitol Police Board shall take such action as
3 may be necessary to carry out section 1.

4 **SEC. 3. CONDITIONS RELATING TO PHYSICAL PREPARA-**
5 **TIONS.**

6 The Architect of the Capitol may prescribe conditions
7 for physical preparations for the event authorized by
8 section 1.
